Qualifying Criteria

The recipient must:

1. Attend Pine-Richland High School and has been a student from 9th through 12th grade and will graduate with the class.
2. Be a member of the National Honor Society for two years.
3. Participate in the same interscholastic athletic program for at least three seasons.
4. Participate in at least five extracurricular activities at some point throughout his/her high school career within school or community.
5. Possess strong character and leadership qualities.
6. Be accepted to an accredited four-year college or university program.
7. Include three Recommendation Insight Questionnaire forms (At least one needs to be from a teacher and one from a faculty member or coach).
8. Please include an essay (100-150 words) on why you should receive this scholarship.

To be considered, a candidate must complete an application and include a resume, three Recommendation Insight Questionnaire forms (at least one needs to be from a teacher and one from a faculty member or coach), an essay and his or her high school transcript. Applications will be due on Friday, April 9, 2010.
