GALLAGHER-LYNNE 2010 SCHOLARSHIP

The Gallagher-Lynne 2010 Scholarship is \$5,500. The scholarship will be awarded to one eligible applicant who meets the ***qualifying criteria*** and satisfies the ***application requirements*** set forth below.

The Pine-Richland Opportunities Fund committee responsible for awarding scholarships will select the recipient of this scholarship, from among eligible applicants. The Pine-Richland High School College Information Coordinator will be a non-voting participant in the committee's deliberations with respect to the award of this scholarship.

The scholarship award will be paid directly to the business office of the appropriate college or university.

Applications for the Gallagher-Lynne 2010 Scholarship award are due Friday, April 30, 2010.

An applicant for the Gallagher-Lynne 2010 Scholarship award must meet the following ***Qualifying Criteria*** and satisfy the following ***application requirements*** in order to be eligible for consideration for this scholarship:

Qualifying Criteria for Gallagher-Lynne 2010 Scholarship

1. Applicant attended Pine-Richland High School for her/his entire junior year and reasonably expects, at the time of application, to attend Pine-Richland High School for her/his entire senior year.
2. Applicant reasonably expects to graduate from Pine-Richland High School in June 2010 (***funding of scholarship is conditioned upon graduation in June 2010***).
3. Applicant is admitted to a fully accredited public or private four year college or university with her/his course of study toward BA or BS (or equivalent) degree to begin no later than September 2010 (***funding of scholarship is conditioned upon such admission***).
4. Applicant attained G.P.A. of 3.0 for junior year and reasonably expects, at the time of application, to attain G.P.A. of 3.0 for senior year (***funding of scholarship is conditioned upon applicant attaining G.P.A. of 3.0 for senior year***).
5. Applicant demonstrates financial need for this scholarship in order to attend the college or university to which the scholarship funding is to be disbursed. Special

consideration will be given to those applicants who can demonstrate that they will be unable to attend that college or university without this scholarship.

Application Requirements for Gallagher-Lynne 2010 Scholarship

6. Applicant submits a ***brief*** written statement explaining how the applicant's life experiences and family circumstances (including financial circumstances) help or hinder efforts by the applicant to attend a four year college or university. Applicant must attach the statement to the application.
7. Applicant submits the completed Gallagher-Lynne 2010 Scholarship Application.
8. Applicant submits at least one Recommendation Insight Questionnaire (***in the form attached to the Gallagher-Lynne 2010 Scholarship Application***) completed by a Pine-Richland School District High School teacher who has taught the applicant in the applicant's junior or senior year. PRHS Guidance Office must attach the Questionnaire(s) to the application.
9. Applicant submits the applicant's high school transcript. PRHS Guidance Office must attach the transcript to the application.

- e. Attach a ***brief*** written statement explaining how your life experiences and family circumstances (including financial circumstances) help or hinder you efforts to attend a four year college or university.

Be certain your application is complete before submitting.
