HEALTH SCREENING PROGRAM

Dear Parents:

It is the policy of the Pine-Richland School District to comply fully with all State mandated medical and dental examinations required for school age children. These include:

- Each child be given a vision test annually.
- Each child in kindergarten, first, second, third, seventh and eleventh grades be given a hearing test.
- Each child be weighed and measured annually.
- Scoliosis screening for fifth, sixth, seventh and ninth graders.
 1. Required by the Department of Health in grades 6 and 7.
 2. Required by local Board Policy in grades 5 and 9.

The School Health Act of Pennsylvania also requires that:

- Each child have Physical examinations in kindergarten or first grade (new enters), sixth and eleventh grades.
- Each child have Dental examinations in grades kindergarten, third, and seventh.

We prefer you have these two exams done by your family physician/dentist, but if private care is not possible, we provide these exams at school. If your child needs the school exams you will be notified in advance.

Children whose dental or physical examination are not returned completed by October 1 will automatically be scheduled for the examination at school.

This health screening program form will be valid throughout the child's entire time in Pine-Richland School District.
