# **SERVICE COORDINATION UNITS**

**SCU:** Service Coordination Units provide behavioral health services in different areas throughout Allegheny County. Consumers may access services by using their medical insurance, or fees can be set based on a sliding scale. Depending on the program or income eligibility guidelines, some services may also be free of charge. These agencies offer a wide range of treatment and support for children and adults whose functioning is impaired by mental illness, intellectual disability or alcohol and other drug dependency. Consumers may choose their Service Coordination Unit, but they may find it more convenient to start with the program that services their area.

# **BLENDed SERVICE COORDINATION**

**BSC – Blended Service Coordination –** If a child is experiencing more significant serious emotional disturbance(s) that interfere with his or her ability to function, and he or she needs to receive treatment from two or more mental health providers or publicly funded systems, (such as Education, Child Welfare or Juvenile Justice), a Blended Service Coordinator would assist the family and child in coordinating these services. A blended service coordinator will also serve as a link and advocate between multiple systems to ensure the child gets the services that he or she needs. A Blended Service Coordinator will meet with the family/child in the home, at school or in the community, as needed.

**Intakes can be done at the office, over the phone, or in the home. Agencies have up to 30 days to receive an evaluation.**

# **FAMILY CENTERED SERVICE COORDINATION**

**FCSC**- Family Centered Service Coordination is an approach to coordinating mental health (MH) services and supports for families served by child welfare, when two or more members of the family are experiencing—or are at risk of experiencing—serious mental illness or serious emotional disturbance. FCSC is intended to focus on the needs of the entire family and will coordinate a holistic plan that addresses not only the individualized needs of specific family members but also the needs, goals and priorities of the family.

# **HIGH FIDELITY WRAP AROUND JOINT PLANNING TEAM**

**JPT**- Joint Planning Team supports families with children 5-21 years old with a mental health diagnosis who are involved with multiple systems experiencing complex needs. Wrap Around facilitators address the unique needs of the child and family to develop an individualized care plan working to maintain the child safely in their home and community with appropriate support and resources. Caregivers are partnered with a Family Support Partner who provides peer-to-peer support to the family and assists them with engaging in the process and advocating for their needs. Older youth are partnered with a Youth Support Partner, a young adult professional who has personal experience as a youth with the human service system or juvenile probation. A Youth Support Partner mentors and shares their insights with the youth currently in the system and assists them in advocating for their needs.

# SUPPORTS COORDINATION

Allegheny County  
Office of Developmental Supports Intake (ODS) : 412-253-1250

*ODS registers eligible individuals with Intellectual Disability (ID), Autism, Developmental Disability (DD) prior to age 9 and Medically Complex Condition (MCC) prior to age 22 to connect them to Supports Coordination and other supports and services. Eligible individuals can work with a Supports Coordinator (SC) while working with other helping professionals, for instance, a Service Coordinator.*

SC – Supports Coordination – Every person registered with Allegheny County Office of Developmental Supports (ODS) receives a Supports Coordinator through a Supports Coordination Organization (SCO)

The role of a Supports Coordinator is usually described in three ways:



Locating Services – helping you find ways to meet your needs.



Coordinating Services – Helping you access services that will help you.



Monitoring Services – Making sure that you receive services in the safest and best way to meet your needs.

**IBHS** – Intensive Behavioral Health Services Intensive Behavioral Health Services (previously BHRS) are mental health services provided to youth in their home and community settings. They are sometimes called wraparound services and may include Mobile Therapy, Behavioral Consultation, and Behavioral Health Technician services. IBHS are for children that have a serious emotional or behavioral disorder that can best be treated in the home and/or in the community.

# **FAMILY FOCUSED SOLUTION BASED SERVICES**

**FFSBS** – Family Focused Solution Based Services are in-home intervention structured to meet the Treatment/Support Services needs of both parent and child. ***FFSBS are only able to be utilized with the parent as the identified client.***

FFSB are delivered in the home and community by a team consisting of a master's level clinician and a bachelor's level family support specialist. FFSBS are designed to integrate mental health treatment, family support services, and service coordination, and are intended to reduce the need for out-of-home placements by enabling families to maintain their role as primary caregivers for their children and adolescents.

# **COMMUNITY AND SCHOOL BASED BEHAVIORAL HEALTH**

**CSBBH** – Community and School Based Behavioral Health Services are services for children with a severe emotional and/or behavioral need that interferes with their functioning at school, at home or in the community. Services include individual, group and family therapy as well as behavioral management, crisis intervention and referrals. Your child is only able to receive this service if it is offered in the school building where your child attends school.

CSBBH services are delivered in the school, home and community using a team approach. Each CSBBH team consists of at least one Masters’ level Mental Health Professional (MHP), one or more Bachelor’s level Behavioral Health Workers (BHW), and consultation with a psychologist or psychiatrist.

# MULTISYSTEMIC THERAPY

**MST** – Multisystemic Therapy is a multi-faceted, short-term, home and community-based intervention for families of youth with severe psychosocial and behavioral problems. MST is an intensive family and community-based treatment that targets delinquent, violent, or juvenile offenders, both male and female.

**To be eligible for MST Services, the adolescent MUST:**

- Be 12-17 years of age
- Be residing in a family setting with a caregiver, or returning home after any type of placement
- Have a caregiver who is willing to participate
- Have active Medical Assistance Coverage
- Be exhibiting chronic, violent, delinquent behavior and/or serious emotional problems

**If the family is receiving outpatient services, partial hospitalization, or IBHS services, the mental health professionals working with the adolescent must agree to a referral to MST.**

# **FAMILY BASED MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES**

**FBMHS** – Family based Mental Health Services are voluntary mental health services for children and teenagers with serious emotional and/or behavioral disorders, as well as their families. FBMHS is for children who may need other out-of-home services if intense in-home services are not provided.

In addition to family therapy, FBMHS can provide around-the-clock crisis intervention to decrease the possibility of a child needing to leave home due to a crisis situation.

# **ACUTE PARTIAL HOSPITALIZATION PROGRAM**

**PHP** – Partial Hospitalization Programs provide mental health treatment delivered in a clinic or school setting, to assist a child in transitioning from inpatient treatment or for prevention of psychiatric hospitalization. Typical treatment lasts 10-14 days.

Mercy Partial Hospitalization works towards stabilizing a child's crisis by offering a day program designed for those who are leaving an inpatient setting or need more treatment than is available from outpatient services. The program separates children into elementary, middle school and high school groups. The structure of each day includes three hours in a Pittsburgh Public School therapeutic classroom, two hours in a therapeutic group, and one hour of milieu therapy.

Western Behavioral Health Partial Hospitalization treatment offers a supportive environment of highly structured time, four to five days a week, for up to 20 hours per week. The program provides individual, family, and group therapies, and medication management. Transportation is not provided by the program.

The Wesley Family Services Acute Partial Hospitalization Program provides the child with short-term crisis prevention and stabilization and referrals for special education placement or therapeutic help. The program is linked to a transitional school program so the child can keep up with coursework. By living at home during treatment, the child feels secure, and families stay together. Following treatment, the child moves onto a more specialized school setting, or returns to his/her community and school better able to face issues and meet his/her goals.

# **NON-ACUTE PARTIAL HOSPITALIZATION PROGRAM**

The non-acute partial hospitalization programs in Allegheny County are housed within school buildings and do not need to be written into an IEP. These programs are open to youth residing inside and outside of the school district where they are located. The treatment team consists of a psychiatrist, master's level therapists, mental health specialists and academic support staff. Average length of treatment is 6-9 months. Youth receive their treatment and education through the non-acute partial hospitalization program throughout each day.

# **INPATIENT HOSPITALIZATION**

**Inpatient Hospitalization** - Acute level of care that includes a short hospital stay, during which youth receive around the clock medical care and intensive therapeutic interventions including intensive family intervention, individual and group psychotherapies, and medication management. Inpatient hospitalization can be utilized to ensure the immediate safety of the youth or those around him/her due to mental and behavioral health crisis the youth may be experiencing. The focus of treatment is to address the crisis or behaviors which led to up to the hospitalization and provide stabilization for the youth in order to discharge to a lower level of care.


