The Community College of Allegheny County (CCAC) is offering a Summer Math Program that can help students get ahead. CCAC offers courses for middle and high school math credit. Students who attend public high schools or other private schools may attend our summer math program. We create an official transcript to forward to your home school upon successful completion of the course(s). These courses can be taken for advancement to obtain credit for middle and high school math classes to accelerate the student's academic progress or to lessen the load of courses during the regular school year. Students can also audit the classes (no grade) to help strengthen their skills.
