

Pine-Richland High School Student Driving Guidelines

Entering Campus

- Student drivers will be assigned a numbered parking spot matching the number on their driving permit.
- Safety Check: Please be sure to buckle safety belts, remove earbuds, ignore cell phones/devices, and maintain an appropriate and safe speed at all times.
- Student drivers must proceed immediately to their numbered spot after entering the campus.
- Student drivers and any passengers must exit the vehicle and enter the school as soon as the vehicle is parked.

Exiting Campus

- Student drivers must wait until all buses have exited campus before leaving their parking spot.
 - Students are encouraged to wait in the building until the buses have departed campus.
 - Safety Check: Please be sure to buckle safety belts, remove earbuds, ignore cell phones/devices, and maintain an appropriate and safe speed at all times.

Parking

- Students must display their driving permit on their rear view mirror at all times while on the secondary campus.
 - Students who do not display their driving permit will receive a warning from the High School Administration.
 - Repeat offenders will receive Level II discipline consequences and risk loss of their parking permit.
 - Habitual offenders will be referred to the Northern Regional Police Department.
 - Drivers may receive a parking ticket and/or be towed at the owner's expense.
- Students must park in their assigned space.
- Parking Permits are non-transferable and may be used only by the student to which the permit is assigned.

General Expectations

- Student drivers must obey all posted traffic directional signs.
- Student drivers must obey all directions given by Pine-Richland High School and Middle School staff members.
- Student drivers must comply with posted speed limits (15 MPH on campus).
- Student drivers must keep their vehicles under control and within the defined driving lanes.
- Student drivers are responsible for the actions and safety of all passengers.
- Student drivers must yield to school buses.

- **Driving privileges may be revoked for any one or more of the following:**
 - Unsafe driving and/or actions by driver and/or passengers.
 - Leaving the building or property without permission from the main office.
 - Students are not permitted in the parking lot during the school day without permission from the office.
 - Improper use of the permit (e.g. parking in a space other than the one assigned, lending a permit, etc.).
 - Poor school attendance/tardiness.
 - Car trouble which results in tardiness or absenteeism is NOT an excused absence.
 - If a student is tardy because of traffic congestion, it is considered an unexcused tardy to school. Student drivers should allow ample time to drive to school and be in their homeroom before 7:45 A.M.
 - Loss of driving privileges for a specified consequence for school misbehavior.
- Students may not transfer their driving permit to any other individual.
- Students may not duplicate a driving permit.
- Student drivers may not cause unnecessary noise (i.e. repeatedly engaging their horn in non-emergency situations, playing loud music, revving their engines).
- The school is not responsible for damage incurred in the parking lot.
- All vehicles on the school campus are subject to be searched by the school administration.

Failure to follow driving guidelines may result in disciplinary consequences as defined by the Code of Conduct or the revocation of the driving permit without reimbursement.
