Follow these steps to make the most of your scores:

**YOUR CB ACCOUNT:** Log in to or create a College Board account online using the access code provided in the College Board email to see scores and test performance feedback.

**SAT PREP:** Get free, personalized SAT practice. The PSAT/NMSQT is great preparation for the SAT®. Your score unlocks a free, personalized practice plan through Official SAT Practice on Khan Academy®. Visit [satpractice.org](https://satpractice.org), create an account, and link your College Board and Khan Academy accounts for a plan based on your test results.

**SCHEDULING FOR NEXT YEAR:** Receive AP course recommendations. Your score report identifies AP® courses that are the best match for you. AP can give you an edge in the admission process and earn you college credit while in high school, which saves time and money in college.

**EXPLORE CAREERS:** Connect with Roadmap to Careers under the Popular Tools tab in your online score report. Answer questions about what you like to do to see careers that interest you, what degrees you'll need, and what high school courses to take. Watch video interviews with people in professions related to your interests.

**YOUR FUTURE:** Get started on BigFuture. Begin your College Search using BigFuture™. Explore colleges, majors, and careers based on your interests.
