Passes are available for cash only. There is no limit to the number of tickets you may purchase.

Seven Springs all-day tickets cost \$58 (regularly \$69) for Monday to Thursday, and Sunday to Thursday twilight tickets are \$46 (regularly \$63 to \$83).

For Hidden Valley, all-day tickets for Monday to Thursday are \$43 (regularly \$45 to 50) and Sunday to Thursday twilight tickets are \$39 (regularly \$44 to \$48).
