The Pine-Richland Board of School Directors would like to invite interested members of the community to consider serving as a school director. Due to the resignation of a school board member, there is a vacancy available for residents residing in Region 1 (for more information see [voting regions](#) and/or map [here](#)). Contact the board secretary if you are unsure of your voting region.

When seats become available on school boards, the board is charged with appointing a person to fill that seat until the next municipal election, which will take place this year. **This appointment would be for the remainder of the term, expiring on December 5, 2021.**

To qualify for the available seat, the applicant must be at least 18 years of age or older and a resident of the district for at least 1 year. Candidates should also have an appreciation of the importance of service to the community, and a desire to guide, collaborate, and work with a team. An ideal candidate would elevate the board values of professionalism, engage with the team, and collaborate to support the district mission and vision.
