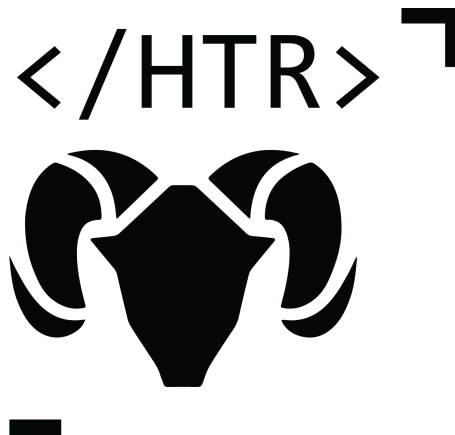

Virtual College Planning Night

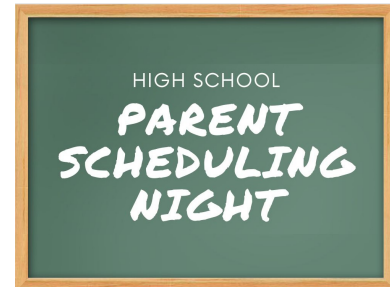

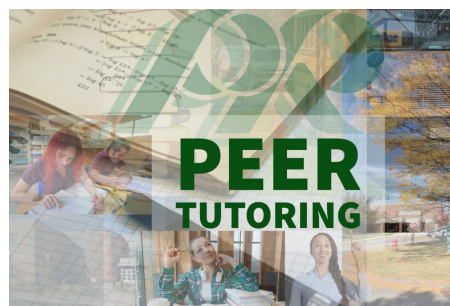
