



Junior Year Timeline 2019 - 2020

- All Year**
- Maintain your grades, activities and volunteer work. Don't join more than you can handle.
 - Do college research through the Internet, Naviance, Guidance Office & public library.
 - Meet with college and career representatives visiting the PRHS College and Career Center. **Ask about current majors, careers, admission requirements and scholarships.**
 - Contact colleges for open house dates. Sign up to receive admission information.
 - Use Naviance to prepare or update your resume.
 - Create an appropriate SAT/ACT testing timeline. Attend an SAT/ACT workshop at PRHS.
 - Register with the NCAA Clearinghouse if you plan on pursuing Division I or Division II intercollegiate athletics. Go to: www.eligibilitycenter.org
- October**
- Attend Financial Aid Night – PRHS Auditorium on October 03, 2019, 6:30 PM
 - North Pittsburgh College Fair - La Roche College on October 07, 2019, 6:00-8:00 PM
 - Take the PSAT on October 16, 2019. Use Naviance Test Prep/Khan Academy to prepare.
- November/
December**
- Research college majors, related careers and potential future salaries.
 - Complete Pennsylvania State required Naviance career lessons.
- February**
- Attend the National College Fair – David L. Lawrence Convention Center, Pittsburgh
 - Job shadow or interview a professional in your field of interest.
 - Review senior year schedule with your guidance counselor/admission representative.
 - Research summer enrichment programs. (List in Naviance, Summer Enrichment Handbook)
- March**
- Take the SAT- Saturday, March 14, 2020, at PRHS. Use Naviance Test Prep/Khan Academy
 - Visit colleges during spring break or take the virtual tour online.
 - Research if colleges require the SAT Subject test.
- April**
- Take the ACT test on Saturday, April 04, 2020, at PRHS. Use Naviance Test Prep or the ACT to help you prepare.
 - Ask two teachers/counselor to write a letter of recommendation for you. Provide a resume and brag sheet (Naviance); remind your teachers at the beginning of the new school year.
- May**
- AP Exams
 - SAT offered at North Allegheny High School on May 02, 2020
 - Take the SAT Subject tests- if required by college
- Summer
2020**
- SAT offered at North Allegheny High School on June 06, 2020
 - Take the SAT Subject tests - if required by college
 - ACT test offered on June 13, 2020
 - ACT test offered on July 18, 2020
 - Make arrangements to officially visit colleges. **Inquire about admission requirements.**
 - Start researching and applying for scholarships.
 - Begin drafting your personal statement for your college applications.
 - Attend the Application/Transcript/Teacher Letter of Rec. Workshops held at PRHS.
 - Update your resume.
 - Review your high school transcript. **Report any discrepancy.**
 - Compile a list of reach, target and safety schools. Use Naviance to access past historical data.
