 - Meet with college and career representatives visiting PRHS in-person or virtually. **Ask about current majors, careers, admission requirements and scholarships.**
 - Contact colleges for open house dates. Sign up to receive admission information.
 - Use social media (Instagram, Twitter) to learn more about your colleges, technical schools.
 - Use [Naviance](#) to prepare or update your resume.
 - Create an appropriate [SAT/ACT testing timeline](#). Attend an SAT/ACT workshop at PRHS.
 - Register with the [NCAA Clearinghouse](#) if you plan on pursuing Division I or Division II intercollegiate athletics.

 - Job shadow or interview a professional in your field of interest.
 - Review senior year schedule with your school counselor/admission representative.

 - Ask two teachers/counselor to write a letter of recommendation for you. Provide a resume and brag sheet ([Naviance](#)); remind your teachers at the beginning of the new school year.
