

Message Regarding Student Support for School Safety

Dear PRHS and PRMS Parents/Guardians:

On March 14, 2018, students from around the country are planning to show their support for school safety and to honor the victims of the school shooting that occurred in Parkland, Florida in February. They are demonstrating this support through a 17-minute quiet gathering.

We have been working with some of our high school students who have expressed interest in participating in this show of support. Although the district does not encourage or promote this exercise, we support our students, value their voice, and care deeply for their safety.

We recognize some students may not want to participate. Those students will remain in class and continue their learning activities under teacher supervision. For those choosing to participate, Northern Regional Police officers, our district safety coordinator, and staff members will be on hand to supervise the students.

As always, the safety of our students is our priority. Students are not permitted to leave campus and will be under the direct supervision of staff members. If a student leaves school grounds the absence will be treated as an unexcused absence.

Visitors to campus will be restricted from 9:45 a.m. - 10:30 a.m. on March 14, 2018, to ensure the safety of our students. **Parents arriving for kindergarten registration during this window of time will be greeted at the entrance to the campus and directed to the appropriate parking location.**
